



NVQ Level 2 Amenity Horticulture



What is it?

A course for students in year 10 and 11 which provides the opportunity to develop new skills and gain a useful qualification.

The course is aimed at students who may be more suited to an outdoor learning environment and benefit from a hands on approach to learning.

As well as providing a vocational learning approach, students attending the sessions will work towards an NVQ Level 2 in Amenity Horticulture and may work on placement with other organisations once the NVQ work is complete.

How the course is run

The project will be delivered through Groundwork Solents existing work sites which are primarily based in Gosport.

The training will be delivered by Groundworks in-house teams who have long running experience in all aspects of Amenity Horticulture and will be supervised by the Programme Manager. Each session will be run by one supervisor and an attendant sessional worker who will also be experienced in delivering Amenity Horticulture.

Those attending will learn in a structured environment how to deliver practical Landscaping and Horticultural projects in the commercial environment and may have the opportunity to also work on placement with other Landscaping companies on completion of the NVQ work.

Groundwork will undertake all necessary health and safety checks and management for these placements.

What students will get from the course

For a cost of just £2050 each student will receive 42 days training and work experience and be entered in to study for an NVQ Level 2 in Amenity Horticulture.

support students through the process of evidence gathering and examination.

provide steel toe capped worked boots and other Personal Protective Equipment as appropriate.
